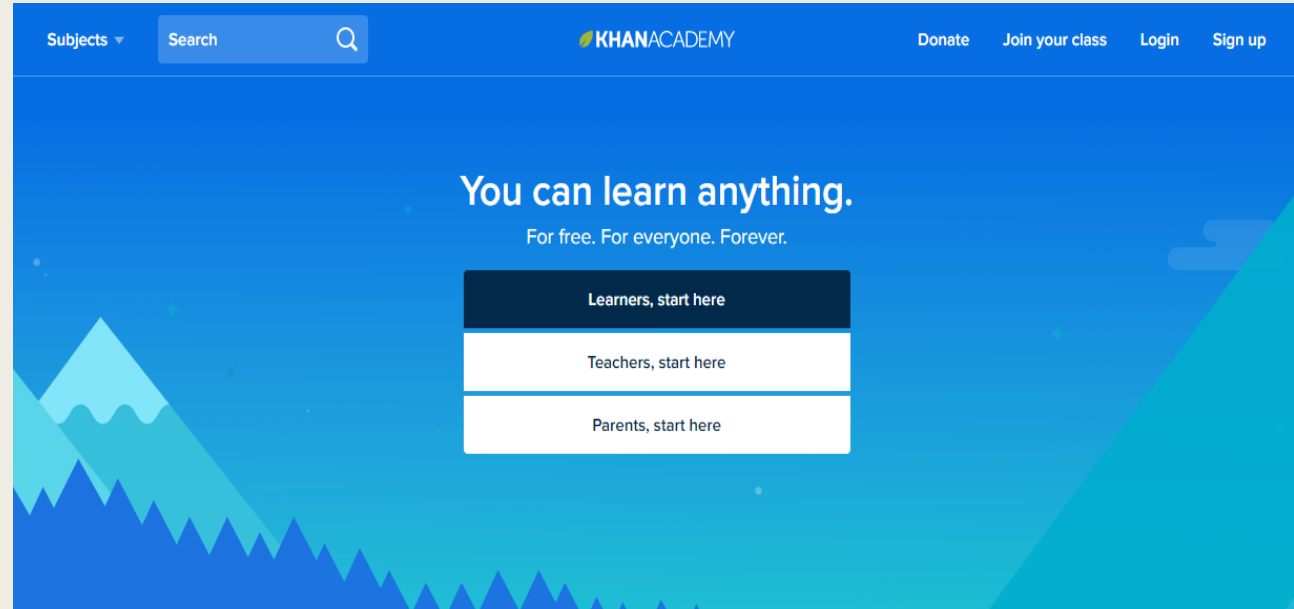

Linking Your Account to Khan Academy

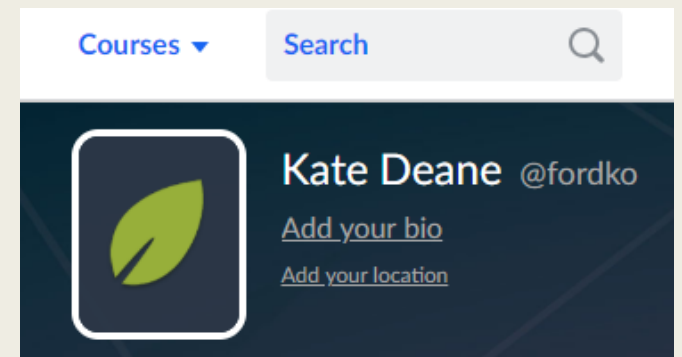
STEP 1 -

STEP 2 -

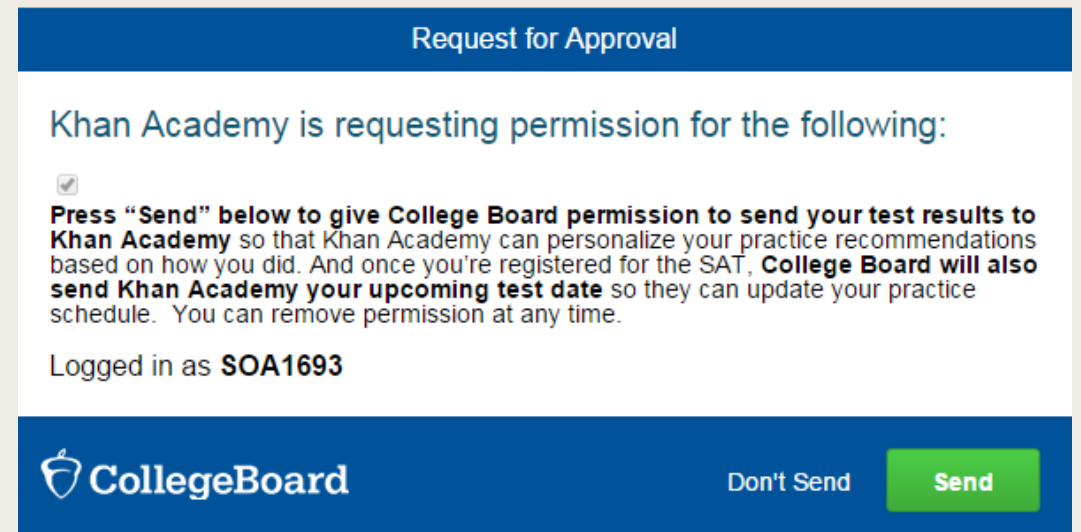
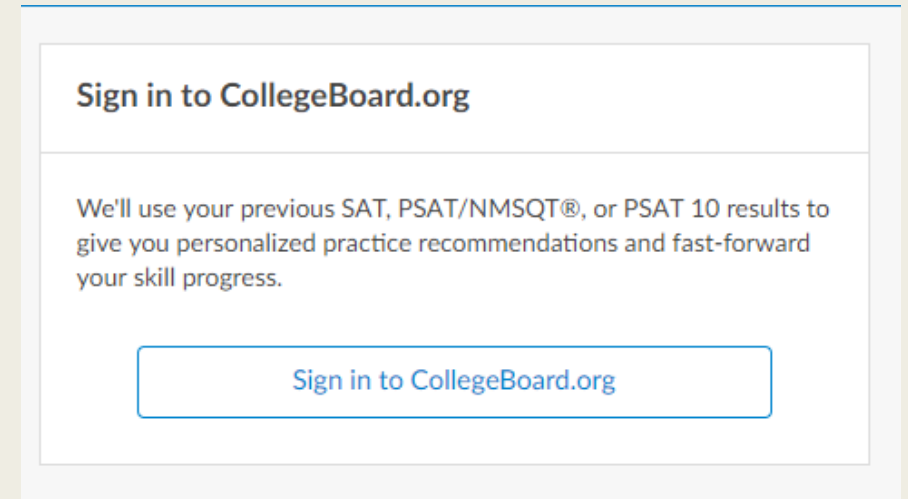
- Select '**COURSES**' on the top left above your name
